Students prepare throughout the school year as a team. Teams of 5 compete at a one-day event in May. Test structure will include both a written and an interactive problem-solving section. Six testing stations include **soils, forestry, aquatics, wildlife ecology, current environmental issues,** and **team presentations.**
